RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All games, sports and recreation must be in harmony with the rules of the EC Church as found in the *Discipline*.
2. Games, sports and swimming are permitted on park property between the hours of 1:00 p.m. And 5:00 p.m. on Sunday unless they interfere with a service being held in the park.
3. All noise that would disturb people outside one's own cottage must cease at 11:00 p.m. Excessive noise at any time is not permitted.
4. All activities and gatherings must conform with the teaching, beliefs and social practices as delineated in the *Discipline* and rules of the National Conference of the Evangelical Congregational Church.
5. Marking or defacing any property is prohibited. Parents are requested to instruct their children to have respect for the auditorium and not to run around on the platform while playing.
6. Do not cut or abuse trees or shrubbery in any way on park property. If you have a tree that needs trimming or removal, notify the Grounds & Maintenance Committee.
7. Open fires may not be built in the park. Fire Rings/Pits are permitted only in adherence to the approved Policies and Procedures established by the Board March 8, 2021. The Grounds and Maintenance Chairman must approve the ring/pit before the first fire start.
8. Automobile owners are expected to observe all regulations and parking rules. DRIVE CAREFULLY, always watching for children. Observe one-way streets and speed limits. Obey all traffic signs. Do not drive on pedestrian walks (Beechwood, Central, Grandview, Prospect, Waldheim, Woodland) exceptions apply to unloading and loading only.
9. Board permitted trucks, campers, trailers, boats, or U-Hauls may be parked in the lower parking area away from access roads and utility poles, or in the lot West of West Avenue, or East of the ball diamond for a maximum of seventy-two (72) hours, provided it does not infringe on the rights of others.
10. All garbage and rubbish must be placed in designated containers for pick-up. Regular garbage collection schedules will be maintained for two dumpsters during the summer and one for Out of Season Residents. Discarded furniture, appliances and other materials must be removed at the cottage owner's expense. KEEP THE PARK CLEAN!
11. Hunting, gunning, and the discharge of firearms and fireworks are positively prohibited in the park. The use of air rifles is prohibited.
12. Pets are not allowed to run loose in the park. DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH and the owner is responsible to clean up after their pets.
13. Waldheim believes in the proper, reverent observance of the Lord's Day. No work shall be done that is not in harmony with the Christian observance of the Lord's Day as described in the *Discipline* of the EC Church.
14. During CAMPMEETING and ALL OTHER RELIGIOUS SERVICES, no recreational or work activities are permitted, and all quiet must be observed.
15. The swimming pool is for residents and their guests and persons attending camp meeting, and only such other persons or groups of persons as shall have received express permission from the Board of Directors shall be allowed to use the pool. No swimming will be permitted when services are in progress in the park.
16. Established dates of the season are MAY 1st to OCTOBER 31st. Residents are not permitted to occupy cottages outside of these dates without written approval of the Board of Directors.
17. Cottage owners, who desire to rent their cottages to anyone, must receive permission from the Board of Directors before doing so. (Rental Applications are available)
18. The riding of bicycles after dark or during services is prohibited in the park. This prohibition is for the safety of the residents of the park. Safety helmets for riders are highly recommended. PA Law requires children to wear helmets.
19. Cottage numbers are set by the Board of Directors. All numbers must be of the approved size and reflective and be placed at the location designated by the Law-and-Order Committee. This is for emergency identification.
20. The cottage owner is responsible for the cleaning of leaves on their leased property by June 15th of each year. The owner will be assessed a fee, in addition to the maintenance fee, if their property must be cleaned by the park. All leaves must then be moved to the NEAREST ROAD by the cottage owner for pick up by Grounds & Maintenance.
21. Disagreements among Park residents or guests shall be subject to Biblical resolution as written in the EC Church *Discipline*: Part Six - Conflict Resolution.
